

2005 VINA GARCES SILVA AMAYNA PINOT NOIR

DRINK: 2007-2012

The 2005 Pinot Noir is dark ruby-colored. It has a lovely nose of raspberry, strawberry, rhubarb and violets. The sweet fruit has attractive spice notes as well as moderate depth and elegance. It is reminiscent of a premier cru Savigny-Les-Beaune from a good vintage. Drink it over the next 3-5 years.

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2005 VINA GARCES SILVA AMAYNA CHARDONNAY

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The 2005 Amayna Chardonnay is light gold in color. It delivers buttery, apple, pear, and floral aromas buttressed by firm acidity and a sense of restrained elegance. This tasty Chardonnay should drink well over the next 2-3 years.

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The 2005 Amayna Sauvignon Blanc from the cool climate Leyda Valley is a candidate for best Sauvignon Blanc from Chile as well as an awesome value. The high-class nose of fresh herbs, citrus, and lemon-lime leaps from the glass. On the palate this supple, harmonious wine reveals pit fruits and remarkable length. This is great stuff worth buying by the case. It should drink well for 18-24 months.

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
